Janab Mohammed Ali Ashraf sahib,

Last time when I called you about Delhi BOCW Board you told me to talk to Shri Vijay Kaushik Dy. Secretary and yesterday when I talked to Shri Vinay Kaushik, he told me to talk to you hence this letter.

Now that you have issued a Circular on 9th June 2020 to advance the dates of verification for renewal in view of the Pandemic COVID-19 and direction of the Hon'ble High Court and also signed the nineteen-page short affidavit, I am sure that I should address this letter to you.

I want to draw your attention towards the online registration of Shri Pramod, painter vide application number 51380000059938 dated 19th May 2020. He was call to the office of the Dy. Secretary North West Delhi on 10th June 2020 between to 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

On finding the papers presented by him in original on 10th June 2020 which enclosed with online registration on 19 May 2020 allright he was asked to pay a fee of Rs 74 and issued the receipt number 100776.

Besides enclosing the above two receipt we are also enclosing a photo copy of the page 2-3 and 6 of the Identity Card issued to him u/s 13 of the BOCW Act 1996 and u/s 266 (8) of the Delhi BOCW Rules 2002.

It is clear from the above documents that Shri Pramod was registered as a beneficiary on 18th February 2016. He has paid his annual contribution on 8<sup>th</sup> February 2016, 20 February 2017 and 18 April 2018 during the process of manual registration and now on 19th May 2020 he has given his APPLICATION FOR RENEWAL OF MEMBERSHIP OF REGISTERED CONSTRUCTION WORKERS from the forth Row Type of Services.

But it is not clear from the earlier Row <u>Applied For</u> whether his Application was for 'Application for Registration as Construction Worker (Rule 266 (4))or Voluntary Data Updation or Renewal of Existing Manual Registration'.

You have informed the Hon'ble High Court in your affidavit that the BOCW Board has received 27,099 application for registration and 4064 for renewal by 11<sup>th</sup> June 2020. A total of 703 number of registration and 297 renewal were approved/granted till 11.06.2020(Page 4 para 3 a ix.)

On page 14 para and d.i you have further stated that as on 11.06.2020 approximately <u>1100</u> <u>building workers</u> have approached the Delhi Board <u>for the purpose of verification</u> and <u>1000</u> <u>such workers</u> have been <u>issued</u> registration (703) and renewal (297) certificates.

On page 14 in para d.ii you have further informed the Honourable High Court that in respect of 189 workers (eligible for relief) the amount of Rs 10,000 each (thereby treating such renewal workers at par with those whose registration status was "live" as on 24.03.2020) has been sanctioned and transferred at the end of the Delhi BOCW Board amounting to a total of Rs 18,90,000 ( Rupees Eighteen Lakh Ninety Thousand only), and it is expected that the said amount will reach the said workers by DBT via the concerned bank, within the next 3-4 working days.

Is he among the 703 who have been issued <u>registration</u> or among the 297 who have been issued the <u>renewal</u> certificate?

We request you to please display the list of all the 1100 beneficiary workers who have approached the Delhi BOCW Board till 11<sup>th</sup> June 2020 on the Board Website with full details, including the Cybercafe or the trade union through which they have been registered to avoid all apprehensions about irregular preferences given to few for one or the other considerations.

Please take this letter also as a reminder to my earlier letter of 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020 to you. Expecting an early response and action on both these letters.
